

Hella's Shareholder Committee has made important personnel decisions at the management board level of the company:



- The management contract of Bernard Schäferbarthold has been extended through 31 October 2024. Schäferbarthold will continue his successful work as Managing Director for the corporate division Finance, Controlling and Information Technology.
- Dr. Frank Huber, the current Deputy Managing Director for the Lighting business division, will take over the management of the division from CEO Dr. Rolf Breidenbach, starting this coming 1 June.
- In addition, Stefan Osterhage, a longstanding member of the management board, will retire as planned at the end of this month. His areas of responsibility in logistics and process management will be distributed among the existing management board team; the management board will therefore be reduced to a total of five people.
