What is our Booth Size?

- Shared booth is 6m²: 2x3m
- Standard booth is 12m²: 3x4m
- XXL booth is 18m²: 3x6m
- Platinum booth is 24m²: 6x4m

What do you provide on the booth?

- For Shared booth: 1 power outlet
- For Standard Booth: 2 tables, 4 chairs and 1 power outlet
- For XXL Booth: 3 tables, 6 chairs and 1 power outlet
- For Platinum Booth: 4 tables, 8 chairs and 1 power outlet

Is the floor carpeted or bare? Are we allowed to place our own flooring? Am I allowed to use the wall of the venue?

The floor is bare but very sensible. If you want to lay carpet, please only use the adhesive provided. You are welcome to contact directly the Stamm company for this.

You can't attach anything to the wall (posters, screen, etc).

What is the height allowed in the exhibition room?

It is 3 m height maximum. You can't have any side wall on your booth, only back walls are allowed. Please note that if emergency exit signs are obscured by the stand height, additional pictograms must be used.

When can exhibitors send their materials to the place? Is there anything they should know/do when shipping their materials to the place?

In the case of very large exhibits, the supplier must ensure that the equipment is brought directly to the conference floor. We cannot help with unloading a truck!

Only printed materials can be sent in advance (such as flyers), and **no more than 1-2 days in advance**. There is no space for long-term storage and large quantities.

Please add the name and date of the event tagged on your package.

Shipping Process: Important info must be stated on every box:

- The event name: DVN Munich Lighting Workshop
- Date of the event: 4.+5.02.2026
- Your company name & booth number
- Each of your boxes should be numbered i.e. if you send 3 boxes = "1/3, 2/3 & 3/3"

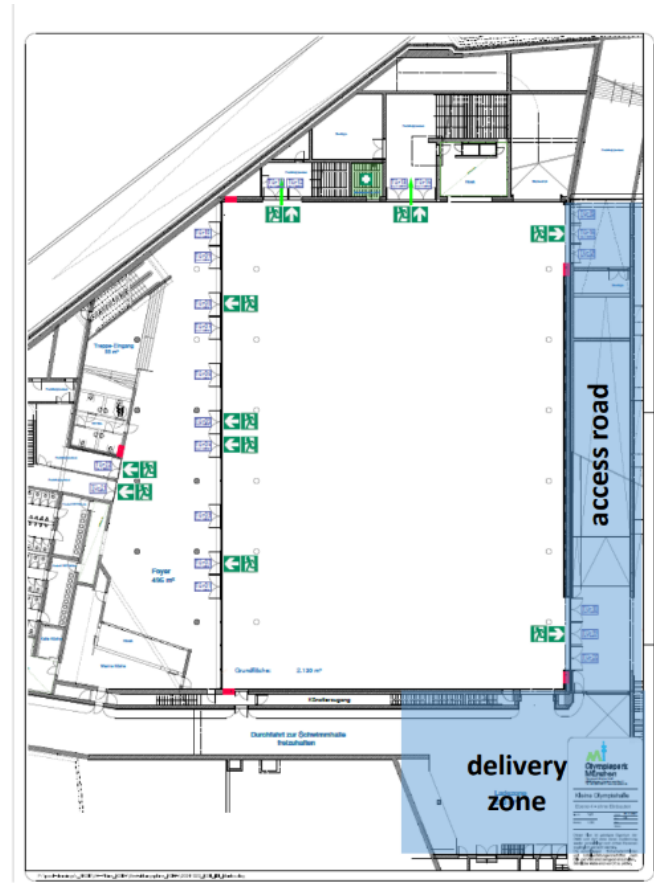
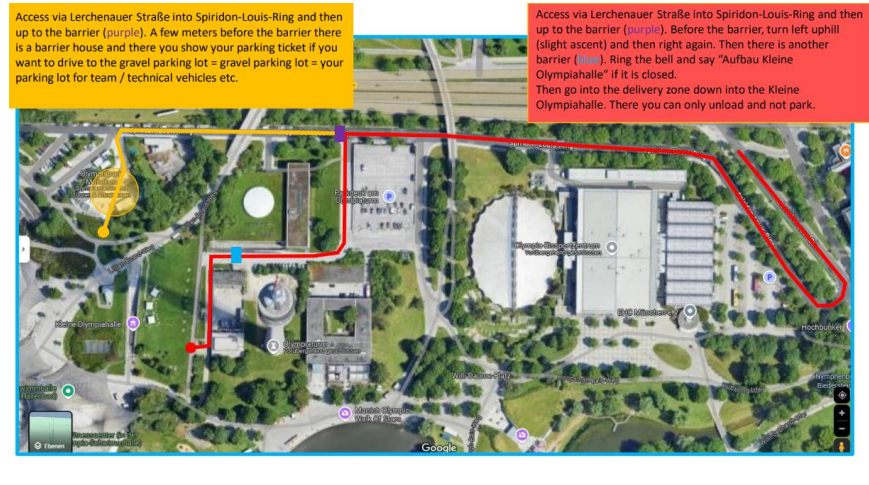

Is there a loading dock or area for deliveries? What are the delivery hours?



From what time can you set up your Booth?

You can build your booth from 8:00 am on February 3, 2026.

From what time can you tear down your booth?

The exhibition area must be cleared before **11:00 pm. on February 5, 2026**. You can start dismantling when the conference will be over. It is not allowed as long as the public is still present.

Are we allowed to store empty boxes/cases on-site during the event?

You can leave only empty, closed technical cases in the delivery zone of the Small Olympic Hall.

What do I have to provide to DVN & what are the deadlines?

You only need to provide 1 static PPT slide (PPTs with many slides and video will not be accepted). **Deadline is January 15th, 2026.**
